The Installation of Officers is scheduled for June 23, 2011 at 7:30 PM.

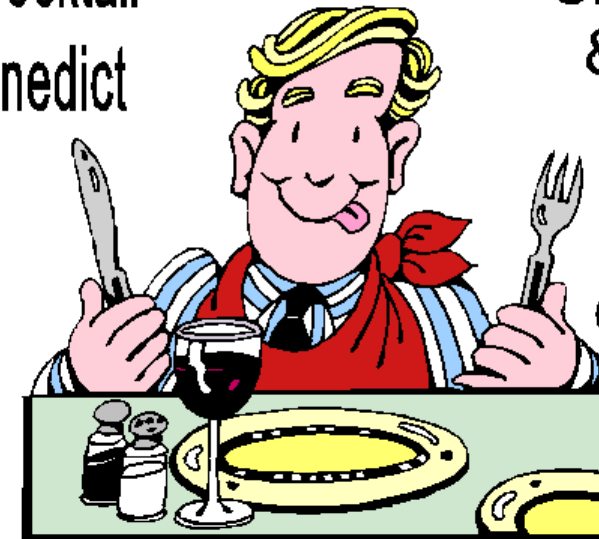
